The harvest is plentiful...

Last week I spent two days in Cornwall, joining with Christians from many different churches to share the gospel on the streets as part of the launch of a mission to the county. My reason for attending is that next year we are launching a similar mission in East Sussex from the 3rd to the 10th June. I arrived in Falmouth in time for the Wednesday evening meeting where the churches came together to spend time in God's presence, to worship, to pray, and to share testimonies from the day. Although I was tired from the journey, this was a refreshing and richly blessed time. There was a real sense of unity among the churches and a longing for more of God's Kingdom in their town; it is no surprise therefore that there was such a tangible sense of God's presence in the

The following morning I went down to the Anglican church in the centre of town where people came together to be trained in the approach to evangelism that was being used. I was followed up and invited to talk further about the greatly encouraged by the amount of people who came having never done anything like this before, and also the people who had not been involved in any 'organised' evangelism such as this for many years. The simple nature of the approach which employed a short and easy-to-use script designed so that it could be used by anyone meant that the maximum amount of people could be involved. It was like mission was being taken out of the hands of the well-seasoned evangelists, releasing the whole church to be involved.

After a time of training, a cup of strong coffee and a short time of praise and worship, we went out on to the streets in pairs. We were prayerfully

looking out for those we should speak to, coupled with a good dose of common sense and social awareness - e.g. the person sitting on a bench was generally a better person to approach than the person running for a bus! The second day that I went out, we had loads of great conversations with people, we prayed for around a dozen people including atheists, and we led three young adults in a prayer of commitment to Jesus Christ. It was amazing how people responded to the gospel, many who had never heard it before. Of course there were those who didn't want to know, but there were far more who wanted to hear and even those who were ready to ask Jesus to come into their lives - in five days, almost 100 people in Falmouth alone took this step.

Of course, I have returned just as the hard work of discipleship and follow up is getting started. Most of those who pray on the streets give their contact details and every one of these people will be journey they have just started over a coffee with a Christian from one of the local churches with a view to discipling them in their new found faith. Not all the seeds will fall on fertile ground but the Bible tells us that some will and that is why we do this!

On Thursday just gone I joined with over 70 leaders from churches in our county to start preparing for next year's mission here in East Sussex. Please pray for a real unity in the Spirit and that God would be preparing us all and equipping us to begin to bring in the harvest which he has in mind.
