

# Remember, remember...

Gunpowder, the recently aired television mini-series, details the events leading up to the fateful night in 1605 when a now infamous Mr Fawkes was discovered under the houses of Parliament with a fair few barrels of a certain black powder. Nothing new there we might think.

What's interesting though, is that the mini-series was an account of the famous plot of 1605, only on a much fuller level - certainly compared to the one that I had prior to my viewing. What is interesting is that the star of the piece, Kit Harington, is a direct descendant of the character he portrays Robert Catesby - the one who devises the plot to blow up Parliament and kill the king. The ring leader if you will. It was wanting a fuller and 'truer' story to be told that caused him to develop, produce and star in the mini-series.
