

A hundred years from now...

At a cost of about £3000, a cataract operation to replace the lens in the eye is one of the best cost/benefit pieces of surgery available in this country. To restore full vision (with a better than 95% success rate) is such a fantastic thing - and available on the NHS in this country to anyone who needs this operation. What a remarkable blessing – and one blessing of which I have enjoyed the benefit. It re-opened doors to pleasures I had lost (including the easy use of my camera!)

The Oxford English Dictionary describes the word "vision" as "the ability to think about or plan the future with imagination or wisdom". Some long time ago, I think even before I began employment by the church, the leadership team put together a document called "2020 Vision". It set out (with that clever title) our aspirations and plans for our local church in the decade or so ahead. It was reviewed a few times, and many of the actions and ideas came to fruition in one way or another probably by about 2015. It was a really helpful guide which gave a framework within which the Holy Spirit gave us freedom to lead.

Imagine my surprise last Sunday morning, the first in this New Year, when Ed challenged us to imagine ahead, not 12 months, not one decade, but ten decades to 2118! In acknowledging that most of us will not be physically present in that year, he asked us what we anticipated the church and our local community to be like at that time? Unless the Lord returns before that date, what are we going to do to play our part in seeing Battle Baptist Church be the bride of Christ in a hundred years from now?



During this past week the Pastors and some of the other leaders from Battle Baptist Church attended the annual Fresh Streams conference in Derbyshire. This gathering provides an opportunity for leaders to both personally and collectively pursue vision. We have been before – but this year has been particularly significant for us. Fresh Streams is a national network equipping, inspiring, connecting, resourcing and giving courage to leaders and leadership teams as we serve our churches and communities.

You don't need a telescope, a microscope or a horoscope to realise the fulness of Christ – and in Christ you have been brought to fulness. He is the head over every power and authority. (Colossians 2 8-10). A phrase that pulled me up short, made me gasp and then almost cry – "Do not ask God to guide your footsteps if you are not willing to move your feet". So how about you? Are you willing do what God asks to see His kingdom come? How are you going to play your part in seeing us move forward in the time ahead – whether that is months, weeks or years!


