

How big is our God?

When I pray to God, I often ponder (in hindsight) just how big, how great, how awesome, how majestic our God is. To awaken and renew my understanding, I decided to do a scan of well over 50 attributes of God that we find in scripture. I expect some folk will think, this is very basic. What I can say is, that I found it to be very helpful, mentally, thoughtfully, and especially when coming before God in prayer.

As you know, it all starts in the first chapter of Genesis...in the beginning God created he created everything – the heavens and the earth, and everything in it. For me, that immediately stops my thoughts about God being someone small. I need to think again of just how big, how wonderful, how awesome, God is.

God saw all that he has created, and as we read, it was very good. How can I believe that God is someone small, if he could wonderfully create all of that? Just thinking about it increases my understanding and belief in God. God the creator of everything – just everything! Wow!

Psalm 46 v 1: "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble." That is something we can all claim. Psalm 77 v 13: "You are the God who does wonders."

Psalm 100 v 3: "Know that the Lord is God; it is he who made us."

Isaiah 12 v 2: "God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid, for the Lord is my strength and my song."

As I read through some of these verses, my understanding and amazement about God grows - just how great God is. It helps me to pray big prayers - its good to know that God hears all our prayers, whether long or short.

What a great God we have – and amazingly he loves us! He made the whole wide world and yet he still loves us. It is so important that we receive his love.

What is true for our praying is also true for our worship. What a great God we have what a great God we worship – what a great God we pray to. And amazingly, he loves us! Nothing is too difficult for him. Amazing!

Let's determine to be bold and pray big prayers, for ourselves, our families, our loved ones, for the church here in Battle, for the church worldwide. for our Government. for the hundreds of thousands of God's creation who are undergoing terrible suffering at this time. As Christians, it is so important for us to stand up and be faithful to our calling.
