Is it a bee? Is it a fly? No it's a Bee Fly!

On Bank Holiday Monday, during that glorious moment which I trust was not the beginning and end of the summer of 2018, we were walking in Brede High Woods. There are so many shades of green as the leaves appear on the trees. Flowers, many of them so tiny that they so easily escape our notice, are in profusion. Seeds from the trees were floating in the gentle breeze and an adder wriggled away as we approached it, sunbathing on the grass. I wish I knew the names of all the different butterflies that were on the wing, although the bright yellow Brimstone was the easiest to identify.

While enjoying a rest from the heat on a strategically positioned bench we became aware of the buzzing sound made by insect wings moving really quickly. Looking down, hovering, then darting rapidly between the flowers, was an insect I don't think I'd ever seen before. A rusty brown colour, covered in tiny hairs and wings that moved with astonishing speed. Although it

When we got home - the joy of modern technology! "Hey Google, what looks like a fly or a bee and has a really long proboscis?" Answer – a Bee Fly! So I then turned to Google images, and there it was! The other clear identifying feature that distinguishes them from bees is that they have two wings, whereas bees have four.

And Bee Flies don't sting! You can find out more fascinating facts if you wish about this rather unusual creature if you wish – but why do I even bother to mention it in the newsletter?

In Isaiah chapter 43 it says "This is what the LORD says—"Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Saviour."

Our God not only made the Bee Fly, he named it. He knows it. He sustains it! It is a part of His great plan – and even though I don't understand how everything God has made all fits together, each part is a crucial aspect of the whole. Likewise God knows you.
