It's fire we want, for fire we plead:

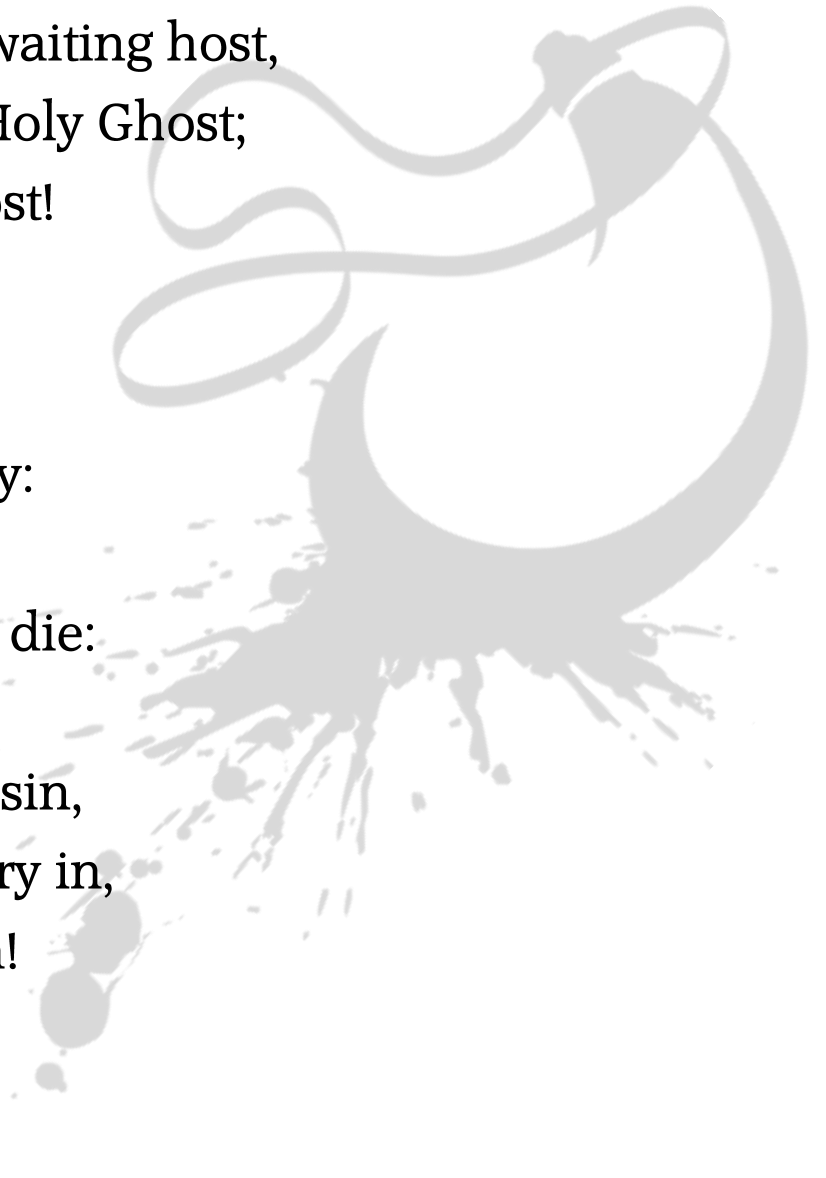

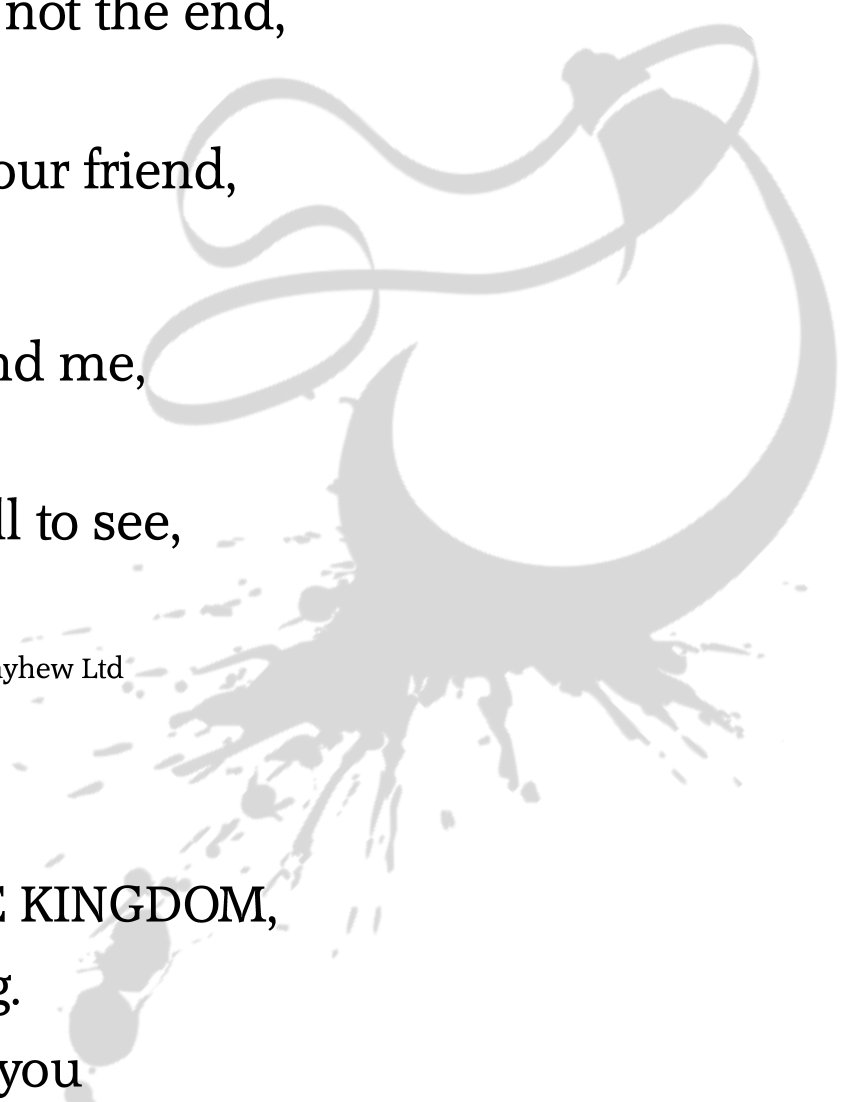
