THE TURNING

Well, here is the good news from The Turning as at 9.45 Friday morning. Over 250 folk have made a commitment and given their lives to Jesus. Praise the Lord. And who knows how many more will do that over the next 48 hours. It is important that we continue to lift them up in prayer, so that they can stand firm against the devil, who of course, will try to snatch it from them. It is so important to keep on praying for them. Pray the armour of God for them.

Of course, one of the positive things that we do not know is just how many more seeds have been sown.

It is important that we remember that we are in a real spiritual battle - it is not a game. It is a battle we have been fighting all this week. It is important now that we do not stop doing that – the battle will continue. We need to pray daily for more folk to come to faith, and to pray for all the folk who have just become Christians. How can people hear and come to faith in Jesus if nobody tells them?

Psalm 24 reminds us of where the battle is: Lift up your heads, O you gates; be lifted up you ancient doors that the King of Glory may come in. It is those ancient doors that is preventing people hearing the gospel. Curses that have been made against the church – promises made by secret societies – idolatry - witchcraft – curses made over the county of Sussex – and of course the modern statement: I am all right jack - I don't need God.

They are those who say, what are you on about – all these things are only a bit of fun? Not so, it is spiritual warfare.

We can break those curses with words of Scripture –Jeremiah 23, that reminds us that God says that his word is like a hammer that breaks rocks in pieces. Use it to break the curses and power of God's enemies.

The importance and power of prayer, using God's word cannot be overstated. Jesus used it when he was being tempted.

The words of Jesus for us today: watch and pray. Lift up your heads, O you gates, lift them up you ancient doors that the King of Glory may come in.

That must be our prayer – that obstacles be removed so that the King of Glory may come in.... that God's word can be heard and received.
