Earlier this week I sat down at my laptop to carry out the annual task of renewing my Anti-Money Laundering registration with the Chartered Institute of Taxation.

I know what you're thinking. This guy really dances daily with excitement.

Unfortunately the whole process took rather longer than expected. It is now necessary to provide a 'basic check', which proves my lack of criminal activity. To obtain this you first have to use the 'government identity checking service' called GOV.UK Verify.

This service is provided by several companies, including Barclays Bank. As a loyal customer of thirty plus years I merrily logged in only to discover that Barclays seem to know me as Mr. 'Le Dunn' so refused to accept that my passport or driver's licence were genuine. By now slightly miffed I tried using the Royal Mail service instead. After all I have been at the same address for twelve years now so surely they know who I am.

After a further half-an-hour and several failed attempts at answering the questions they asked about me I came to the conclusion that either they knew me better than I did or that I had multiple identities in cyberspace which were currently sulking and refusing to speak each other.

How simple then, yet also profound, to consider the spiritual identity ascribed to us by God!

"The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs – heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ" Romans 8:16-17

"Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God" John 1:12

"He predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will" Ephesians 1:5

There is no room for ambiguity. No registration fee or cross-referencing to our financial records. There may initially be a checking of our criminal past, but thankfully God's mercy wipes this clean. We are adopted into His family and become one of His children.

In society we can take our identity from the work we do, from the people we know, from the clubs we belong to and from the family we are part of. This is identification by reference to what is outside of us and what surrounds us.

By way of contrast, in God we take our identity by reference to Who is inside us. "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's spirit dwells in you?" 1 Corinthians 3:16. The Holy Spirit is the seal within us, marking us as belonging to Him.

That is who we are. Part of His family. And that is the identity we should rest all our hope and confidence upon.
