## Nearer my God to Thee.

Nearer, my God, to Thee, nearer to Thee! E'en though it be a cross that raiseth me, Still all my song shall be, nearer, my God, to Thee.

Nearer, my God, to Thee, Nearer to Thee!

As Christians, we often talk about 'how closely we are walking with God' or our 'spiritual temperature'. Our Pastors often ask us on a Sunday to consider whether our relationship with Jesus has developed over the last year, month or week but what do they actually mean? Are they trying to make us feel guilty because if we are honest we haven't really prayed or read our Bible a lot this week? Are they trying to prick our consciences and suggest that if we do more good things then we can get closer to God because there are ministry groups that need help of course...? Are they trying to tell us that if we act in a more 'Christian' manner, smile a lot and seem interested in what everyone has to say then people will think we have a closer relationship with God?

Personally, I don't think they mean any of those things. Of course praying, reading our Bibles, helping out in ministry teams and taking an interest in people are all good things but we shouldn't be doing them as a list to tick off in the belief that they will automatically bring us closer to Jesus. God is our Father, Jesus is our best friend and the Holy Spirit is our constant helper and to get closer to them we need to spend time in their presence. That's it. No more, no less. The more time we spend with them, the better our relationship will be. Human friendships develop as we spend more time with one another and so it is the same in our relationship with God. We need to find the best ways of spending time with God for us personally. Each of us is different and so there will be many different ways for us to explore. For some a guiet time to just sit in God's presence regularly is helpful, for others it may be daily Bible readings, for some a constant dialogue with God about how their day is going

helps, for others a set pattern of prayer helps them to still their mind and focus on what God wants to say to them. Whatever we find is best for us (and this might change over time) is what we should be doing regularly to deepen our relationship with God.

How will we know if it's working?! As with all relationships, it will grow, deepen and mature gradually. One day we will realise that we are talking to God more often and about more things - even the seemingly inconsequential. We will realise that we are asking for God's help and guidance more and more and not just seeking his will for the big decisions in life but also the little ones too. We will be reading our Bibles and praying more often, not because we think we ought to but because we are excited to hear more from God. We will find that not only are we no longer avoiding that person who we found really irritating at coffee but we are actively seeking them out to talk to them because through God's eyes we have grown to love them as our brother or sister in Christ. We will find that we are giving up our time to help in ministry groups, not because we feel we should but because we actually want to and find it enjoyable. All of these things will happen over time as we become closer to God, full of His Holy Spirit and exuding the fruits of the spirit everywhere we go.

I have often been struck by the words of the hymn Nearer my God to Thee and the manner in which it was reportedly played by a string quartet as the Titanic sank. I didn't have space to write all the verses above but the whole hymn has a message of hope with a cheerful melody and I can't help thinking that it must have been of great comfort to those who knew they were about to drown.

Let us not get to the point of thinking we might drown before we deepen our relationship with God and draw nearer to Him.
